Recognized by the “design savvy public,” Laura Kirar is “THE design talent to watch and follow.” Named as one of “America’s Top Young Designers,” by *House Beautiful* in September 2003, Laura Kirar commands a strong reputation for creating elegantly refined spaces and objects. Kirar is founder and director of two companies, TRU design, a NYC-based multi-disciplinary firm that creates high-end residential and commercial interiors and LKDL Miami, focusing exclusively on home product collections for the residential and contract markets. Laura’s designs emphasize the appeal of classic proportions and unique modern forms, revealing her incisive understanding of history and the decorative arts.

A Chicago native and a Fine Arts graduate from the prestigious museum school of the Art Institute in Chicago, Kirar began her career in design at the Merchandise Mart studio of Holly Hunt. After moving to New York in 1995 to work as a furniture designer in the residential field and in retail design with the likes of Ralph Lauren Home, Kirar founded her firm, TRU, in 1999.

Kirar’s early independent project, the Jeanne Maag store, one of the first high end boutiques in NoLiTa was published by *Interior Design Magazine* in 2000. The firm has continued to work on compelling projects in the following years including a Bowery loft renovation, a family compound in Rumson, New Jersey, multiple townhouses on the Upper West Side and the Greenwich Village apartment of a well-known Broadway actor. Kirar’s diverse client list also includes commercial work such as the global spa rebranding for Westin Hotels, East Coast offices for an award winning advertising agency and multiple product licensing awards. Her largest contract is with the venerable Kohler Companies with whom she began her high profile career with a 30 piece bath collection for Kallista in 2005.

Laura Kirar is the only designer to hold concurrent product licenses with all four of the Kohler Interiors Group companies: Kallista Company, Baker Furniture, McGuire Furniture, and Ann Sacks. Her collections range from a full offering of tile and bath fittings to 150 pieces of case goods, seating, lighting and accessories that make up the complete vision of the “Laura Kirar Lifestyle.” As the figurehead and creative force behind LKDL, she also has extensive collections with Boyd Lighting, Carnegie Fabrics, David Edward Company, Dennis Miller Associates, Tuohy Contract Furniture, and most recently Tufenkian Carpets launching in the fall of 2008. A designer with the soul of an artist, Kirar completed her degree in sculpture and interior architecture at the prestigious School of the Art Institute of Chicago. Her passion for art continues to infuse her work with originality and careful attention to detail.

Over the last 10 years, Laura Kirar’s designs have been profiled in numerous domestic and international publications such as *Architectural Digest*, *Elle Decor*, *House Beautiful*, *Interior Design*, *Met Home*, *Space*, *Self*, *Vogue Living*, *Women’s Wear Daily*, *W Magazine*, *Wallpaper Magazine*, *The New York Times*, and *Time Magazine*.
